FREE SERVICES AVAILABLE AT THE FAIR:

- Medical services for women (including pap smears and mammograms) and children (parents please bring immunization records for your children)
- Confidential legal consultations regarding family law issues, child support, domestic violence restraining orders, public benefits programs, immigration, housing, and consumer protection
- Help with obtaining financial assistance including TANF, CalWorks, Medi-Cal, General Relief, Food Stamps and Social Security
- Job application skills, self-defense, and personal care seminars
- Job skills, education, and employment counseling
- Spiritual counseling
- Shelter referrals

FREE CHILD CARE: Activities, breakfast and lunch for children up to age 16.

FREE TRANSPORTATION: The Women's Resource Fair will work with large groups to arrange transportation from areas geographically distant from downtown San Diego. Transportation Request Forms may be filled out at www.wrfsandiego.org before March 9th. Requests are processed on a first-come, first-served basis and space is limited!
